



**Cover image:** When domestic horses (*Equus caballus*) see a herd mate disappearing behind a barrier and then hear the call of a different herd mate played near the point of disappearance, they respond quicker and look longer than when the call matches the herd member just seen. The incongruent combination appears to violate their expectations, suggesting that horses possess a cross-modal representation of known individuals containing unique auditory and visual/olfactory information.
