

Correction. In the article "Structure, expression, and molecular mapping of a divergent member of the class I *HLA* gene" by Rakesh Srivastava, Michael J. Chorney, Simon K. Lawrance, Julian Pan, Zaid Smith, Cassandra L. Smith, and Sherman M. Weissman, which appeared in issue number 12, June 1987, of *Proc. Natl. Acad. Sci. USA* (84, 4224–4228), the authors request that the following be noted. J.P., M.C., S.M.W., and J. Germino have revised the sequence of the divergent class I *HLA* gene termed *RS5* and described in that article. Recently Koller *et al.* [Koller, B. H., Geraghty, D. E., Shimizu, Y., DeMars, R. & Orr, H. T. (1988) *J. Immunol.* 141, 897–904] have described an unusual class I gene they refer to as *HLA-E*. The revised *RS5* sequence differs by <0.2% from the *HLA-E* sequence and therefore probably represents an allele of that gene.
